

On December 20, 2019, in the early hours of the day, I went to watch Salman Khan written and Prabhu Virgo directed the film Dabangg 3. Other Universal Subtitles clients include TED and PBS. Translation of content availability for Khan Academy varies greatly from language to language. Estonian is the most commonly subtitled language, with more than 500 videos available, followed by Polish and Spanish. Dubbed content is available in 16 languages, including Banglu, Hebrew, Malayalam and Swahili. Musharraf tells Fast Company that every language has an official Language Advocate whose job is to test translations for accuracy and fluency. Language Advocates review both subtitles for Khan Academy video and audio dubs. Creating subtitles of Khan Academy videos not only boost site in non-Anglophone non-Anglophone The subtitles also help Khan Academy work SEO magic and lure new viewers through Google and other search engines. In most cases, Khan Academy tries to use one voice-over for each foreign language. Translators are expected to make a significant contribution to investment in time; for example, the Han Bangla Academy project requires at least 20 hours a week of volunteering. The project subtitled Khan Academy began in late 2010 and continues. Current language priorities, according to Musharraf, are Spanish, Portuguese and Bengali. In the long term, Khan Academy also plans to add original content in a foreign language - lectures and chats conducted from start to finish in non-English languages without translation.
